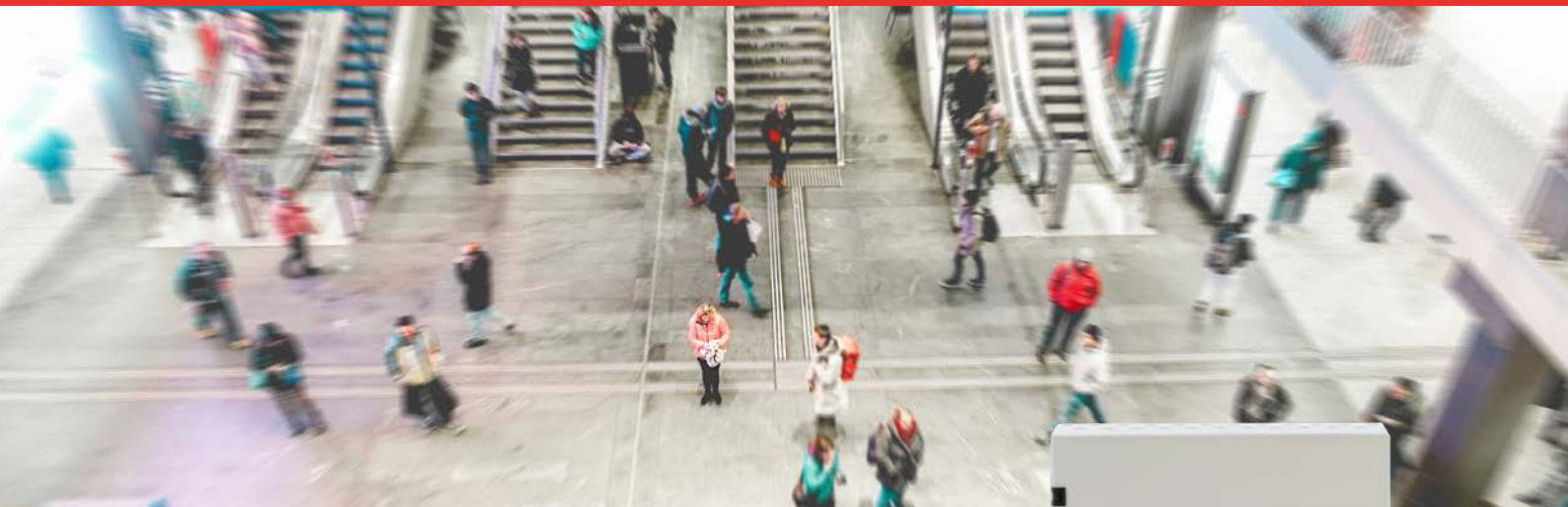




A range of fully-monitored, battery-backed CAST-powered lockdown solutions to aid compliance with Martyn's Law

The Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025, also known as **Martyn's Law**, requires premises with a capacity of 200 or more such as schools, shopping centres, theatres, entertainment venues, large restaurants and other venues to prepare to have public protection measures in place, including **lockdown plans** and clear communications, by April 2027.

LOCKDOWN ALERT is C-TEC's CAST-powered range of dedicated 'invacuation' solutions specifically designed to help organisations comply with Martyn's Law by protecting people during incidents such as **terrorist threats, active attackers or external dangers**. They can be used to direct people to stay inside a building, to move to designated safe areas or evacuate a building should the need arise.

All of C-TEC's lockdown alert solutions – especially our LAP multi-message solution - are versatile, monitored, battery backed, compatible with our ENVISION Cloud based monitoring service and can be tailored to meet the exact requirements of virtually any site.

Typical applications include: Schools, colleges and universities; shopping centres and retail spaces; theatres, arenas and entertainment venues; offices and public buildings with large occupancies.

Multi-message lockdown voice sounders & VADs

Supplied with a library of on-board pre-recorded tones and voice messages with custom/coded messages available to special order.



Secure authorised user controls

Allows the selection of voice messages appropriate to a developing situation such as a partial lockdown, a full lockdown or even an evacuation.

Multi-message Lockdown Alert panel

C-TEC's flagship multi-message lockdown alert system comprises our **LAP2/CA** CAST-powered Multi-Message Lockdown Alert

Panel which is designed for use with a range of CAST-powered lockdown alert call points, tone/voice sounders & VADs and interface units.

Supplied with two CAST open protocol addressable loops and based on our ZFP CAST addressable fire panel, the LAP2/CA is **battery-backed, fully monitored** and allows authorised users to select different tones/voice messages for different scenarios via **secure keyswitches**, including:

- » Partial lockdown (internal or external threat)
- » Full lockdown
- » Full evacuation



Multi-message Lockdown voice sounders & VADs



Supplied with a library of pre-recorded tones and voice messages capable of signalling a full lockdown, a partial lockdown (internal threat), a partial lockdown (external threat) and/or a building evacuation as well as an 'all-clear/situation resolved' message. Sounder and Sounder/VAD versions available with a blue beacon. **Custom/coded voice messages also available to special order.**

Blue lockdown call point

A surface-mounting CAST manual call point that can be used to signal an incident has occurred that requires a lockdown.



CAST interface modules

A range of addressable CAST input/output interfaces that can be used to trigger door locking systems, rollershutters, access control and other security systems when a lockdown situation occurs. Standard, Mains-rated and mini-I/O versions available.



Single message Lockdown Alert panel

C-TEC's simpler, single message lockdown alert solution uses an XFP CAST based single loop

LAP501/CA Lockdown Alert Panel. It is typically used in smaller venues and is capable of generating **one fixed, pre-defined lockdown message** offering lower complexity while still supporting Martyn's Law compliance.

More on Martyn's Law

Designed to improve protective security and organisational preparedness across the UK, Martyn's Law - officially The Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025 - means that those responsible for certain premises and events must consider how they would respond to a terrorist attack.

In addition to this, at certain larger premises and events, appropriate steps to reduce vulnerability to terrorist attacks must also be considered. Through the Act, qualifying premises and events should be better prepared and protected, ready to respond in the event of a terrorist attack or indeed other incidents such as a knife crime incident in a school, an escaped wild animal or a localised chemical leak.
